The 18" waterline on Gateway Blvd has been installed north of CR212 to the Goodyear site. Construction is still ongoing for the onsite waterlines at the Goodyear site.
- **6. Attorney Report, including but not limited to, substantial changes to PUC water regulations.** Attorney James Wilson was not present, so Corey Trail updated the Board on his behalf: Corey informed the Board that James is still working on any SUD conversion processes that have not been completed and that there will be no charge. No changes to report regarding the PUC water regulations.
- 7. Consider and act to approve Resolution 2019-001, adopting the second amended annual budget of Talty SUD for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019. Bill Hart made a motion, seconded by Chris Jackson, to approve Resolution 2019-001. A vote was taken and the motion passed 4-0.

 - (a) Corey reported that water loss was down as there was not a lot of construction or leaks in the month of May.
